

sounding colours

International Messiaen Days Görlitz-Zgorzelec spread a rainbow full of sounds over the Neisse River and guarantee unique, audiovisual impressions.

From 15 to 19 January 2020 the young, Polish-German festival will present the moving history of the former prisoner of war camp Stalag VIII A as well as Messiaen's colourful music.

International Messiaen Days commemorate one of the most unique world premieres of the 20th century. On 15 January 1941 French composer Olivier Messiaen (1908-1992) alongside three fellow prisoners of the POW camp Stalag VIII A performed his piece "Quatuor pour la fin du temps" ("Quartet to the End of Time"). The German association "Meetingpoint Music Messiaen" and the Polish Foundation "Memory, Education, Culture" have been organising an annual performance of the eightpart piece for violin, cello, clarinet and piano for 12 years in a historical venue, where its world premiere took place - on today's Polish side of the twin town of Görlitz-Zgorzelec.

Since 2007, the annual performance of the Quartet became a part of the multi-day festival "International Messiaen Days Görlitz-Zgorzelec". The leitmotiv of the fourth edition is 'sounding colours' and highlights Olivier Messiaen's combination of two sensual impressions: sound and colour.

During the festival artists and researchers will try to bring this artistic expression of the composer closer to the audience, while involving them in the process. They will try to achieve it through installations, extended, innovative concert formats, as well as via comparing Messiaen's works with other composers and artists, who approach in different ways the theme of the fourth Festival edition: 'sounding colours'. Lectures and guided tours will add to highlight the phenomenon of combining different art forms as well as Messiaen's unique understanding of the terms sound and colour.

Artists from all over the world representing various genres of arts will contemplate on the relationship between seeing and hearing both in the memorial centre in the area of the former POW camp, and in other locations situated in the twin town of Görlitz-Zgorzelec.
